

Direct Pay to Claim Federal Clean Energy Incentives

On March 7, 2024, the U.S. Dept. of the Treasury and the Internal Revenue Service finalized the rules for direct pay to claim clean energy incentives.


This is important because, for first time, taxexempt organizations can tap into credits to develop, own, and operate their own clean energy assets. This will help local governments and other organizations shape and build a clean energy economy that meets local needs, including workforce development.

Clean Energy Tax Credits

The Inflation Reduction Act provides clean energy tax credits for specific entities that invest in and produce clean energy. These clean energy tax benefits are available to entities that have been historically excluded from claiming them, such as state, local, and Tribal governments; non-profit organizations; U.S. territories; and other tax-exempt entities like schools, hospitals, and places of worship.

Qualifying entities can receive tax credits as direct payments from the Internal Revenue Service, streamlining these entities' access to key incentives and supporting their investments in local communities.

Some of the credits relevant to local governments are shown in this slide from the Center for American Progress.
