SB 5811 – ZEV Rulemaking

- **Fleet considerations**
 - What does a model year 2025 availability of passenger cars, light-duty trucks, and medium-duty vehicles mean for your procurement and transition plans?
 - How will the adoption of the Advanced Clean Truck (medium- and heavy-duty ZEV requirements) rule impact your fleets?
 - What, if any, data collection will be needed to support the development of these rules (CA requires a statewide MD and HD fleet inventory as part of the rules?)

 - Will my vehicles be able to use biofuels?
 - How will I procure biofuels, new EVs, charging/refueling infrastructure?
 - How will the state/local government/utility help me comply with the LCFS?
